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Welcome

There are a few new things to note for this year:

New "Scratch Ensemble" class for Guitarists. A chance for all soloist to join together just for fun to experience playing in a large ensemble. See Guitar syllabus for information.

Adult choirs, please note we have changed the classes of entry and now invite you to bring a 15 minute mixed programme to celebrate the style and talent of your Choir.

Having held our spectator fee for more than 10 years, we will now be charging adult visitors £2.50 for day-long entry to the festival on Saturdays 14th and 21st March. There is no change to the voluntary donation to watch the Adult Choirs on the afternoon of Sunday 22nd March.

The Gala Concert also remains a £5 entry for Adults. This year we are very excited to welcome Rose Gosney, Young Musician of the Year 2024 quarter finalist, both as an adjudicator for the morning of the String Section, and also performing at the Gala Concert.

The theme of the festival is "Celebrating Local Talent". Our aims are as follows:

- » To encourage people of all ages and abilities in the local community and surrounding areas to take an interest in music, whether choral, vocal or instrumental.
- » To provide an opportunity for learners to benefit from the guidance and encouragement available from experts in their field.

Our objectives in running a friendly, local festival are:

- » To offer an opportunity for musical students and experienced musicians to learn and benefit from performing in front of their peers and expert audiences.
- » To provide an incentive to study music and an environment conducive to developing musical skills and talent.
- » To facilitate individual personal development through the emotionally enriching experience acquired through musical expression.
- » To enhance the cultural life of New Milton and surrounding areas by hosting and promoting live and serious music.
- » To foster community spirit in New Milton and surrounding areas through offering an opportunity for voluntary support to the Festival for both individual members of the community and the various service organisations.

For 2026, there is a change to the classes of entry for the Adult choirs. Instead of multiple classes in different musical styles you are invited to bring a 15 minute mixed programme that showcases your choir's style. There are two main adjudicated classes of entry: "Community Choirs" and "Competition Choirs". These may not be the ideal description of your Choir, but you are asked to join the class that is the best fit:

COMMUNITY CHOIRS will typically be those whose focus is local, give charity and occasional public performances and generally don't audition for participation.

COMPETITION CHOIRS will typically be those who are available for private hire, and/or take part in BABS or similar competitions and/or have an audition process.

We will maintain a Performance Platform class (slightly shorter in duration) for those who are not used to public performances, or do not wish to be adjudicated.

Those entering the Performance Platform and Community Choirs will form the first half of the Sunday afternoon Festival. Adjudication will be given after all choirs have sung. Then, after an interval, the Competition Choirs will sing, with their adjudication concluding the afternoon.

Priority will be given to Performance Platform and Community Choirs to practice in the hall on the risers before the first half begins. Choirs singing in the first half are requested to 'leave the hall' after their performance to encourage and create easy access for the Competition Choirs. Any Competition Choirs wishing to practice in the hall will be asked to do so after the first half.

Regulations

1. Competitions are restricted to amateurs, an amateur being one whose main occupation is not in teaching or performing the subject covered by the class.
2. Entries must reach the Section Secretary by or before the closing date (31st January 2026), accompanied by the appropriate fee(s). On-line entries will only be accepted and processed once payment is received by the closing date (see also reg 15).
3. A performer's age is reckoned as on 1st September 2025.
4. An entry by a competitor under 18 shall be submitted or signed by a person over 18 on the competitor's behalf.
5. The submission of a paper entry form or on-line entry shall be deemed as acceptance of the Regulations of the Festival by the competitor or signatory.
6. Notice of withdrawal should be made in good time to the Section Secretary. The entry fee will be forfeited.
7. A maximum of 4 entries per person, across all classes.
8. A copy of Own Choice music must be brought on the day for the adjudicator. Photocopies are allowed ONLY if the piece to be performed has been selected from a collection already purchased by the competitor.
9. All solos should be performed with piano accompaniment unless expressly written for unaccompanied instrument or voice. Audio backing tracks will be allowed for groups or choirs (own equipment to be used). No audio or backing tracks or microphones to be allowed in any other circumstance.
10. If the OFFICIAL ACCOMPANIST is required then their fee must be included with the entry. Music or photocopies for the official accompanist MUST reach the Section Secretary by 1st March 2026. The original, not photocopies, must be used for the performance.
11. Competitors are asked to keep to the time limits so that classes do not overrun.
12. Competitors are invited to announce their chosen piece; should a competitor prefer, the class steward will do so.
13. Certificates are awarded in the following categories: COMMENDED, HIGHLY COMMENDED, MERIT, DISTINCTION and HONOURS. Trophies are awarded to Class winners, usually for Merit, Distinction or Honours, at the adjudicator's discretion.
14. The adjudicator's decision is final.
15. Payment: Cheques are to be made payable to NEW MILTON MUSIC FESTIVAL. If entering on-line, payment can be made by cheque or bank transfer or PayPal. You MUST quote the on-line booking reference number for any on-line method of payment.
16. For ALL entries, including school or large group entries, please ensure a personal contact tel. no. for the leader (NOT the school number) is given on entry form.
17. ITEMS FOR THE CONCERT, to be held on Sunday 22nd March 2026 at ARNEWOOD SCHOOL, will be by invitation and also at the adjudicator's recommendation: competitors will be contacted by telephone after the close of the competitions, or on the Saturday afternoon/early evening.
18. If you entered the festival last year in a graded class we usually expect that you will enter the next grade up this year. If you won a medal last year we request that you definitely enter the next grade up this year.
